We are making plans to go to the Dominican Republic on the 20th of March and come back on the 4th of April. There are many Haitians there and we'd be having some evangelistic meetings as well as personal witnessing. The missionary is from the DR, but got saved in Tallahassee and worked in an independent Baptist church for a while starting a bus route. The church he is out of, Gospel Light Baptist Church, said they would help us some with the trip. If you could help it would be much appreciated.

Meanwhile, things are progressively getting worse in Haiti. Maybe half a mile above where we lived most of our time in Haiti had problems with a gang. The people in the area got money from family and friends in the states, hired some mercenaries from the Dominican Republic. They gave a dance and the gang members who came got their heads removed. Gang activities slowed down and the gang went into hiding.

You think prices are high here. In Haiti, gasoline can run for as much as \$50 per gallon, An egg is almost \$1. Poor countries depend on transportation so, since they don't have car they must rely on public transport to get around or to take their goods

Be praying for the money to come in plus that the Lord will bless as He did this past May when we had three young people saved and seventeen men from our men's meeting.

We praise the Lord for your support and trust you are praying too. Jesus said "Without me ye can do nothing," in John 15:5. We desperately need Him all the time.

I got a good report from the doctor after she saw the results from my blood test. She was very pleased from all the readings and said, "The older you get the better you are." That is a blessing from the Lord for which I thank Him most every day.
