



With the news we received last week from Pam's last PET scan and that the standard chemo treatments are not being effective, we began to look into some alternative treatment options. Last year we got an email from a pastor about a cancer treatment place in Arizona called Envita. A missionary he knew had received treatment there when there was nothing more his doctors could do but try another chemo regiment, which had not worked for them previously. The Lord used this place to get him the treatment that was effective in his cancer battle. Pam called and spoke with their patient coordinator and was able to schedule a consultation appointment and lab work to be done on February 27 and 28 in Scottsdale, AZ..

Envita has a high success rate treating stage 4 esophageal cancer. One downside to treatment centers like this is that insurance companies will not cover their services. We will not know the options for treatment or the exact cost until after the consultation and lab results come back, but they said the cost can range from \$40,000 - \$120,000. We have some money in savings and a retirement account that I will cash out, but it will not be enough to cover the total cost. Our church has set up a medical fund for Pam's care that friends and family can give to, to help with the cost. If you would like to give to this, the address is:
