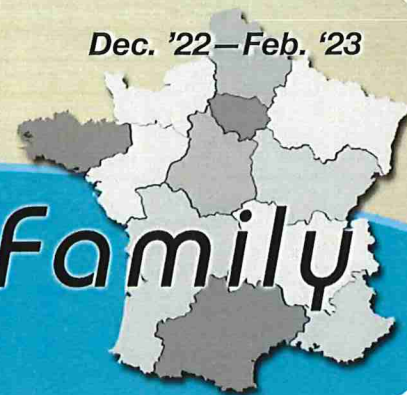

France The White Family



We're excited to be in a new year of ministry in France! We're excited about opportunities to connect with people and the growth we've seen and continue to see in our church.

Christine is a new Christian who's been coming for several months. She's around 80 and has lost all her children. This makes Christmas a very difficult time for her. She had only been saved for a few months leading into the Christmas season and she missed several services during the holidays. Despite this, God has been working in her life and she's coming faithfully once more. If you would, please pray for Christine in three ways. First, that she'll grow in her faith. Second, that she'll find comfort and healing in the Lord. Finally, that she'll get baptized soon.

A few weeks ago, a Nigerian woman named Deborah came to church. She's newly arrived in the country and is seeking asylum. This past Sunday, as I looked across our church, I realized that the African immigrants in our church outnumbered all other attendees. It brings joy to my heart to know that God is using this church to reach both French and Africans for His glory! Please pray that Deborah would be saved.

A little over a year ago, we were introduced to Patrice. He's from Cameroon and has been seeking asylum here in France. The process hasn't gone well for him, and he may leave our area soon. He's been faithful to church and while both Danny and I have had several opportunities to share the gospel with him he has been fixated on the idea that good works are a big part of salvation. So, with his possible departure, please pray that God will open his eyes to true salvation through Jesus alone and that he will accept the truth of the gospel before he leaves.

Please pray for Église Biblique Baptiste de Charleville this year. We are praying that God will increase our church, spiritually as well as numerically. We know God is the one who brings this growth, and we are fully trusting Him and excited to see what He'll do in 2023.
