It brings me immense joy and happiness to write you all about my ministry news and how God is blessing us through your prayers, sacrifices and continuous financial support. Praise the Lord. Words are not enough to express how much we are grateful to you all. We want to say thank you and let you know that we always remember you in our prayers.

Nagaland Baptist College continues to grow. During 2022-23 our college academic sessions graduated 47 students last April and now most of them are already engaged in ministry. Some have gone out as missionaries and others have joined local Church ministries. During academic session of 2023-24 we have already started classes in the month of June 16 and have enrolled 160 students out of which the majority are male students unlike other years.

Our new Nagamese Baptist Church at Naga United Village is growing. In 2022 God has opened another door in West Bengal to do ministry among many tea garden workers in a non Christian area, and three more fellowship programs have started. Amen.

This year the monsoon (rainy) season has started early in the month of April so we are having difficulty trying to travel up in to the mountain areas. We are praying that after the rainy season is over, we are able to visit some new villages. We are also getting ready to have VBS programs in all of our Churches.
