At the end of the week, thousands of pieces of material were passed out, over 900 men and women attended the services and 115 souls were saved, Praise the Lord!

It was such a privilege to be able to spend a week with several of the Rock of Ages missionaries and volunteers at the home office. We worked together in building a much-needed addition to the ministry's office. I pulled out my old tools and was able to do the electrical work and oversee the moving of the walk-in cooler. Praise the Lord for the most part, I remembered how to do the work. Following

the work week, it was back to Vice President work as I was privileged again to teach various classes in our new Candidate Class. Praise the Lord we had three new missionary families added to the ministry.

Papua New Guinea

The recent February trip to Papua New Guinea was an opportunity to introduce to teams of national pastors and their churches as to how they could reach their local schools and prisons, it was exciting. "The Lord blessed our trip to Papua New Guinea with 8 professions of faith in Christ Jesus during the church services – Amen! The prison ministry began while we were there with Bible Baptist Church of Kimbe being the first church in five years to preach in the women and men's prisons. The team was able to preach, pass out hundreds of tracts and the Lord blessed

Ghana West Africa

The February report from our partners shares we are still getting Bibles and materials into the prisons. In the month of February our partners preached 51 services across the country with an attendance of 4753 and 251 professions of faith in our Lord.

Romania

Last year with our 95 volunteer partners we saw the following results:

- 1. 524 preaching services were held in 22 prisons
- 2. Over 2500 prisoners were in attendance
- 3. 201 prisoners made Professions of Faith
- 4. 154 prisoners completed the New Testament Prisoner's Bible Institute lessons.
- 5. We were able to help several Ukrainian refugee families with food, medical and housing.

We are presently working with partners in 20 countries and thanks to your faithful partnership thousand here the gospel in jails, public schools and prisons. Thank you again for partnering with us to share the gospel around the world.
