Though much of our preaching was to help the men grow in the Lord, there were 7 men that came forward to be saved.

One of the goals of the foreign outreach of the Rock of Ages has been to work with well-established national Baptist pastors and their people to see the Lord raise up full time missionaries. Praise the Lord for our missionaries and national partners serving world-wide.

Hungary

Brother Zolts, reports the team was able to distribute 67,000 Ukrainian New Testaments and preach to several Ukrainian and Hungarians this past month. Help us pray as the Pastors are working to see when an opportunity to reach the prisoners will take place. The Lord continues to give favor with the officials in Hungary and we are one of few ministries preaching in the prisons. In addition, the door is opening to teach the Character Under Construction Curriculum in the public schools. Pray as we begin to work on preparing the lessons in the Hungarian Language.

### Papua New Guinea

A recent trip to Papua New Guinea was made where the Rock of Ages was shared with several national pastors. As a result, several churches are partnering with us and this year already over 300 men have made professions of faith. The door is open to several institutions. Help us pray the Lord will raise up a full-time national missionary for this work.

# Ghana

Through our national partners 38 prisons were recently reached. Fifty services were held in the institutions with a 3,346 in attendance and 227 made professions of faith. Brother Shelly will be meeting with two pastors, one in the Kumasi area and the other in Cape Coast. There are several open doors to the prisons and these brothers desire to partner with us to reach the prisons with the Gospel. Pray for the need of Bibles and material as the work continues to grow. In addition, the public-school work is exploding and praise the Lord many church members are volunteering to teach the character lessons.

#### Middle East

Brother Aymen was given 4 hours to hold an Easter service with 1200 in attendance. For a Muslim nation this is truly the hand of the Lord that makes this possible. Brother Aymen is allowed 40 hour of soul winning through the month. He also holds a midweek service with the family of the inmates. Praise the Lord that in a nation where Christianity is to many the death sentence, there was one profession of faith. Due to the nature of the work, we are limited to how much information we can share. We do ask you pray for this dear brother. He is a Rock of Ages missionary and is unable to raise support in his country. Please pray for his daily safety and the needs of his family.
