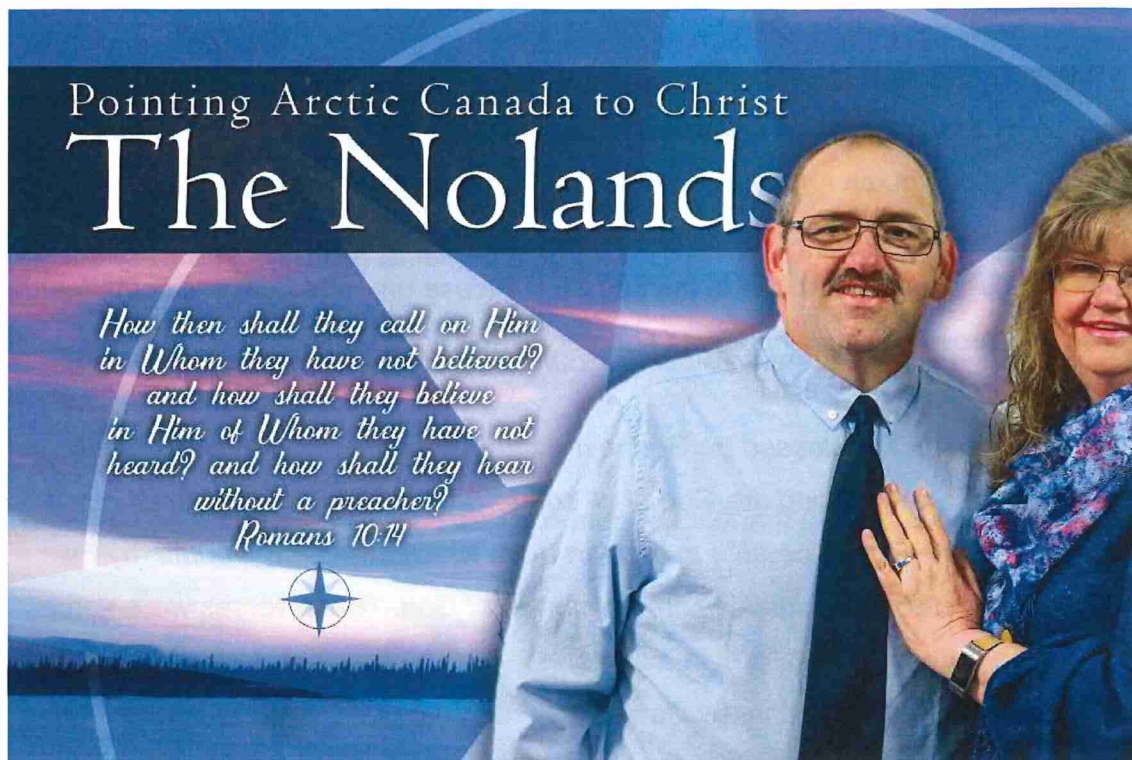


Thank you for your prayers for our family and ministry.
