Thank you also for praying for the new opportunities to reach public schools in Guatemala and Hungary. In both countries, the churches had unavoidable changes in schedule. After talking with the men, we still pray and look to see the work started. We are looking & praying toward early 2024. I think of II Corinthians 4:7-8, "But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power **may be of God, and not of us**... *we are* perplexed, but not in despair." Brazil: After many months of labor and work with our national men, Brother Michael Adams coordinated a team trip to Brazil including some of the ROA leadership, to dedicate the new office & training center to the Lord, and to see the saints encouraged in their labors. Having had the privilege personally some years ago, to help establish our Missionary Candidate School in Brazil, it is a thrill to see this goal reached. I am excited to see how the Lord will use the facilities as He continues to call missionaries in Brazil!

Middle East: Please continue to pray for our national missionary serving in the Middle East. It is a miracle of God that a Gospel witness is even possible where he is serving, but he just sent news that after over two years of laboring about the people he is reaching, over 100 souls were recently saved! If you would like to know more about this work, please let me know - my contact details are below.

Ukraine: Please pray for a slight possibility to explore gaining a small presence once again in a Ukrainian prison. Since the war all prison access was lost, and with our Ukrainian missionary family having to flee and now in the states for a time, we have had no means of taking any steps forward. From discussions with our Hungarian missionary family the Kovacs', he has gained an invitation to visit a Ukrainian prison through a pastor he knows in Ukraine. There is much paperwork involved - please help us pray.
