'Teach all nations' the great commission of our Lord is to make disciples in all nations basically teach others what someone else has taught you. The first Bible verses I ever read were those used to lead me to the Lord at the age of 22. The Lord then led me to a Bible believing Baptist Church. I was blessed to be taught the scripture and challenged to serve wherever needed in the church. When the Lord called me to preach, I had no idea what to do. But I praise the Lord for a pastor and godly men of the church that taught me and encourage me. I have been preaching now over 40 years and I praise the Lord, for the many faithful servants of the Lord that took the time to help me along the way.

This May will be 33 years since we made our first trip overseas as a ministry. We started out looking for men that could translate for us as we preached to hundreds of prisoners. I quickly realize that the Lord had commissioned us to teach and disciple others to reach their prisons. With so many open doors, I knew that we would need partners back home to join us in helping the national families. As men began to partner with us the Lord, He would begin to call them as missionaries. Several foreign families have been trained and now serve fulltime as Rock of Ages missionaries. Thousands have heard the gospel, accepted Christ as their Saviour and now serve faithfully in local churches around the world. Thanks to your investment, the work will go until the Lord calls us home.

The Titus Partner Outreach continues to assist national volunteers and partners in reaching their local jails, schools and prisons. Hundreds serve faithfully every month and praise the Lord families are still surrender as missionaries. In 2023 we had two new foreign families surrender to be missionaries with one man in Africa and one man in Papua New Guinea praying about fulltime service.

The Rock of Ages has offices in various countries where the Prisoner's Bible Institute, missionary training centers and material storage and distribution take place. Often times we forget to mention those that are employed to help keep the ministry operating. Some of the ladies and men have been faithful employees for over 15 years. Given the educational level of our workers, their income would easily be two to three times more then they receive if they took secular employment. These families believe that the Lord has called them to serve in this area of the work. Thanks to the faithfulness of all that pray and give to the Titus Outreach, many are able to serve the Lord in their nation.

We are already seeing great growth with men surrendering fulltime to serve as missionaries and inmates enrolling in the Prisoner's Bible Institute.

Pray--- We are going to have six of our foreign missionaries in the first few months of **2024**, pray their time in the states is not only very fruitful but that it may be a time of refreshing.

PRAY--- the Lord will completely pay our loans off this year.

Please continue to pray for the need to pay off the new office building in Brazil.

36 saved in the Middle East (Because of the area of service we don't name the country.


Thank you again for your faithfulness. We pray this year is one of the greatest yet to be seen.
