We're thankful for the opportunities we've had to reconnect with supporters and friends and share the ministry of France with several new churches. God has been so good, as we've had several express interests in becoming new supporters and had a few increases from other faithful supporters during this time.

We're busy settling back into our routines here in France and looking forward to doing ministry at another church for several months. James Carney, a friend, and pastor whose ministry is an hour north of us in Heirges, France, is on furlough and has asked us to fill his pulpit. Our plan is to be with his church on Sundays and Wednesdays and then here with our church and ministry partners for the Tuesday midweek service in Charleville-Mezieres. We're looking forward to this opportunity!

Mac, our 8-year-old son, has had some ongoing stomach issues for several years. We visited the pediatrician in December and were referred to a specialist. The bigger hospital where we supposed to go to for tests told us they didn't have any openings to give us, but God worked it out and we got into another hospital where we able to set up several appointments in just a few weeks. We're very pleased to say that the tests helped the doctors to diagnosis his condition which can be managed from here in France. We

praise the Lord for working it all out and were amazed at how He answered so many prayers; especially when it came to the last-minute scheduling of some very specialized tests such as a brain MRI and an endoscopy! If you would, please pray for Mac, that we'll see complete healing from his condition which we've learned is not life threatening but will probably be something he deals with for life.

Millie is doing well. We are continuing to learn how to better manage her Type 1 diabetes. We had a good flight back to France, however about an hour before landing her insulin pump began to malfunction so we found ourselves doing an impromptu change in the middle of the Paris Airport after landing. Millie has seemingly adjusted well to the 9-hour time change and is scheduled now for her quarterly Pediatric Endocrinologist appointment in a few weeks. We truly appreciate the prayers for her health.
