The Lord left us with the great commission to go into all the world and teach all nations. The idea is to teach others to become teachers. Paul is exhorting Timothy to look for faithful men and to commit to them, or to invest yourself in their life. Teach them to become teachers! But to do more than just instruct them about things, but bring them to a place that they themselves are teachers. The ministry then continues from one generation to another.

Thirty-three years ago, we made our first trip overseas as a ministry. In the beginning, our primary goal was to evangelize the prisons of the world. The Lord began to raise up men with the same burden to reach the prisoners of their nation. Time after time I received the request, "Please teach us how". We begin to teach how to approach prison officials, what to expect from prisoners and prison staff, safety concerns while in an institution, along with many more things needed to be effective in the institution. We then begin to realize that we had need to learn the various customs and cultural differences and of course the language barrier. The Lord then gave me the scripture to begin what has been the Titus Partner Outreach.

The idea was to partner individuals and churches in committing to faithful men. Over the years, your investments in the Titus Outreach has taught thousands of volunteers and partners that now teach others in their countries to become teachers. Many foreign families that began as volunteers have surrendered their lives and now serve as pastors, missionaries, and faithful servants throughout their countries. Many of these foreign families have faithfully served as missionaries with the Rock of Ages for thirty years.

Thanks to your faithful commitment to give and pray for the Titus Outreach the ministry has fulltime volunteers, partners and missionaries serving on six continents. Every day somewhere in the world a Rock of Ages taught worker goes into a prison or public school and preaches and teaches the Word of God. Everyday somewhere in the world sinners are saved thanks to your faithfulness.

- This year marks the thirty years that Brother Mircea and Sister Ronela Cristian have served as missionaries with the Rock of Ages. Brother Mircea is the first foreigner to be accepted as a missionary with the Rock of Ages. Thousands of Romanian prisoners have been saved and discipled through the work of this dear family.
- 257 saved in the prisons this month was the report from Brazil. Over twenty years ago, you committed to teaching faithful men in Brazil. Today eight Brazilian families serve as Rock of Ages Missionaries.
- Please remember the work in Papua New Guinea. The partners conducted 5 services, with 226 in attendance and 27 professions in Christ Jesus- Amen! There are 22 provinces in the country with a prison in each province. We have access to 5 prisons now and praying to reach all 22 in the coming years. Missionary John Shelley
