Life is returning to normal. Michelle has returned to Uganda and the boys and I survived \bigcirc Life is always busy here between teaching and serving in the ministry. We are so thankful for God's Provision so that Michelle could be there for the birth of Jordan. We try not to dwell on all the family life we miss out on, but its times like this that we are ecstatic at the chances God gives us.



In June the Uganda Board of Education held a meeting to inform us that all Nursery schools that had been registered under the Primary school, now had to be registered and licensed independantly. We had much work to do. They gave all schools 2 weeks to prepare for inspection. In this process they closed many schools that did not pass inspection. We praise God for providing the funds needed to make the necessary repairs as well as the files and the



government fees that were needed to be licensed. In July we passed our inspection and were verbally approved for a 2 year license. The next step will be registering the school after the 2 year license expires.



God has provided for the connection of our staff housing to "Umeme". This is the electric company in Uganda. We have been waiting over 12 years for electricity to come. But it is quite costly to prepare for inspections and to pay for the connections. Our Primary school is already connected. A dear family has given to make this connection as well as to make a connection for our church and Secondary school.
