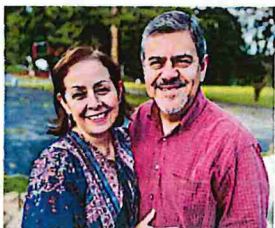


Juan & Teté Alvarez
