These men are dedicated to spreading their faith through evangelism. They reach out to their friends, family, and the people they meet in their daily lives. Their commitment extends to street evangelism and participating in church group activities. Their passion for sharing their beliefs is evident in their consistent efforts to connect with others and share their message.

In addition to their evangelistic efforts, these men are deeply committed to helping others understand and embrace the teachings of God's Word. They strive to guide people in following the Lord's teachings, both in their personal lives and within their local church communities. Their dedication to this mission is reflected in their ongoing efforts to support and mentor others in their spiritual journeys.

Every Tuesday evening, these men gather for prayer and to work through a New Converts' course. They approach this course with a collaborative spirit, working through one chapter together. Afterward, each man takes a part of the chapter and teaches it again to the class. This method not only reinforces their own understanding but also prepares them to teach these truths to others. Their commitment to this process highlights their desire to see others grow in their faith and understanding.

SINTI MISSIONS TO ROMA IN ROMANIA — Menele and Remo are the accepted leaders here in Germany for the mission efforts among the Roma in Romania. They began by traveling with me, and then they assumed leadership. They have been making regular trips at least twice a year to evangelize and help the local church in Tinca with their many outreaches. The Gypsy churches here in Germany support the work financially and with humanitarian aid. The mission work in Romania that our Gypsies in Germany support celebrated 30 years of ministry in June of this year. Menele and Remo have been working with them for twenty-five years. They were there for the celebrations, which included a tent meeting. Over the years a total of 17 churches among the ROMA have been started in Romania, Bulgaria and Ukraine.

MOVE TO BRUCE'S APARTMENT...

This fall, we will be moving into our son Bruce's apartment, which will allow his family—after furlough—to relocate closer to their area of ministry. We've already begun renovating the space, a process that is taking much more time than we originally expected. Since the apartment is literally just around the corner from where we currently live, the transition should be relatively smooth. By keeping both apartments until Christmas, we'll also be able to offer retiring missionaries a comfortable place to stay as they focus on their transition back to the USA.
