Year-End

We closed the year by holding the 20th Missionary Teen Retreat in Aierdi. This year, we had young people who came from Germany, Georgia, and Spain. The teachings and challenges from the Word of God were a great encouragement and blessing to everyone.

At the church, we held a cantata led by our nieces, Deborah and Elisa. The choir did an excellent job, and the message of the cantata was very good. Thanks be to God, there were several visitors who heard the gospel. Another year-end project was the distribution of Christmas postcards to every household, each with a simple gospel message. On this occasion, a total of 62,000 postcards were distributed: 42,000 in our region and 20,000 in a town called Renteria and the surrounding areas. These latter postcards were distributed by a sister church in that area.

We will begin the year with the 63rd Intensive Bible Institute at the end of January. The instructor will be our brother Luis Colorado.

In March, Tete will participate in a women's meeting in Valencia, and afterward we will both travel to Seville to take part in the missions conference led by Pastor Alberto Puente. In April, Tete will travel to teach in a ladies' conference in Texas.

Meanwhile, here in Aierdi we will hold our 5th Apologetics Retreat, which will be attended by young people from different parts of Spain to receive sound teaching. In August, we will hold our retreat for pastors and workers, where Brother Joe Bowker will be teaching. We will also have several work teams visiting us during the summer to help at the farmhouse, in addition to other Intensive Bible Institutes that we will carry out throughout the year. Please pray for us, that the Lord would grant us wisdom!

We will end the year with the first marriage retreat organized by our church. The teachers will be Dr. Ezequiel and Mrs. Miriam Salazar. This year we will also participate in two conferences with the Missionary Link ministry: the first in Sangolqui, Ecuador, and the second at the missionary conference of our church in San Luis Potosí.

Finally, we would like to ask for your prayers regarding a new challenge. Over the years, we have seen the Lord's hand in a very special way. As you may remember, the church initially consisted of two families from our team and three other individuals. Over time, the Lord has prospered His work. Almost 14 years ago, the Lord provided us with a larger facility, as the church had grown so much that it no longer fit in the original one. It seems that we may soon be facing the same situation again.

On Sundays, we are now gathering in groups of more than 120 people, so we are praying for the Lord's guidance and considering the possibility of another facility. Right next to where we currently meet, there is a building for sale—much larger and with many more possibilities. Could this be the next meeting place for our beloved church? Last week we went to see it; the price is €515,000, so we are in need of a miracle.

That sounds familiar! If the Lord has done it in the past, can He not do it again? Pray with us. Once again, the Lord is calling us to count the stars. God bless you!
