Pray and praise God for His good name, knowing we are insignificant. Pray God's people would give to Him graciously. Pray for wisdom as our church takes steps of faith. Pray for our outreach ministry team.

Pray for unity as our church glorifies Christ. Pray for those who lead worship to be encouraged. Pray thanking God for His mercy, and ask the Lord for His presence to be known in believers' lives. Pray for the filling of the Holy Spirit as you surrender your will and plans to His. Pray the Lord will help us plant new churches and renew old ones.

Pray that God would renew the passion and joy of His people as we worship together today. Pray others would join in praising God with us as we share the Gospel here and abroad. Pray for our welcome ministry team. Pray for our Sunday school ministry team.

Pray for families (wards) to come and worship together. Pray for our pastors, deacons, and leaders to follow God's Word and to have wisdom. Pray we will help appoint new people to places of leadership and service.

Pray that God will help you to be faithful to meet with Him, no matter the world’s circumstances. Pray Christians would pray and live with thanks each day. Pray for our transportation ministry team.

Pray and thank God for ways He has blessed you. Pray our thankfulness would produce true humility and needfulness for God’s work to be accomplished in us. Pray for our preschool and children’s teams.

Pray with joy for others you know who are growing in their faith. Pray your love for God and others will grow. Pray for our church and ministries to see many lives changed. Pray for our school and daycare ministries.
