

## **Remind Me How I Got Here**

## Psalm 8

**Interesting Note:** There are many types of Psalms. The Jewish people organize the Psalms in five parts to mimic the Pentateuch (Psalms 1-41, 42-72, 73-89, 90-106, 107-150). A.T. Person suggests these 7 divisions of the Psalms: **1. Of the Scriptures** (1, 11, 119); **2. Of Creation** (19, 29, 104); **3. Of Judgment** (35, 69, 109); **4. Of Christ** (2, 16, 22, 24); **5. Of Life** (3, 18, 44, 60, 68); **6. Of the Heart** (4, 6, 10, 21, 23, 38, 42); **7. Of God** (5, 8, 18, 36, 46, 90, 139).

## Introduction:

Solomon explored life, and he reported a dismal response saying, "Vanity, vanity, all is vanity." That is until He came to the conclusion of the matter: "Fear God, and keep his commandments" (Ecclesiastes 12:13).
