Psalm 127

Interesting Note: *Psalms of Degrees* (means “steps”) or *Ascent* are thought to be sung when pilgrims went to Jerusalem’s festivals, while moving with a certain rhythm step, while ascending the temple’s (15?) steps, or they are personally-selected songs by Hezekiah recognizing the fifteen years God added to his life (Isaiah 38:8, 20). David wrote four, Solomon wrote one, and the other nine have unknown authors (120-134).

Introduction:

Hezekiah, evidently moved personally and spiritually, included this Psalm from Solomon, so we may draw personal applications from the lives of both men who are of the kingly lineage of David and Christ. We must choose the foundation upon which our homes will be built (Matthew 7:24-25).
