Introduction:

Have you ever driven a vehicle with a governor? It's not fun. A *maschil* Psalm is one for instruction. This Psalm uses Israel's early history for the lesson. (See Romans 15:4.) One of the key thoughts is that their relationship with God could have been so much better, but they limited God's work in their lives. The lesson is clear: we can limit God.
