## 3. Prayer for Christ's Return (10a)

Jesus modeled that we should pray for God's kingdom to come. John echoes this prayer in his closing words of the Bible by praying, "Even so, come, Lord Jesus" (Revelation 22:20). Though the coming kingdom of the Lord has not been established yet, we (saved people) are citizens with the mandate to proclaim it and to live according to its rules (1 Pet. 2:9).


In contrast to today's world, it is obvious why we need to pray for it to come! God describes His coming kingdom in the following ways:
